

## **COURSE DESCRIPTION AND OBJECTIVES:**

This program addresses the needs of oral and maxillofacial surgeons as well as advanced general dentists in private and academic practice to obtain updated scientific and surgical information which is pertinent to their clinical practice. The educational format will consist of lectures with question and answer sessions as well as a panel discussion.
