The University of Miami Miller School of Medicine, Department of Surgery and Division of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery is once again offering their annual **Academic Day Continuing Education Program**. The Jackson Memorial Hospital residents will present 20 minute abstracts in the morning based around the theme *“Cases of Great Importance”*. This year’s Mark L. Wein Memorial Lecture will be delivered by our Chairman and “Authority on Osteonecrosis”, *Dr. Robert E. Marx*. He will present a lecture entitled *“Things Have Changed, What Every Dentist and Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon Needs to Know about ONJ”*.

COURSE DESCRIPTION AND OBJECTIVES:

This program addresses the needs of oral and maxillofacial surgeons as well as advanced general dentists in private and academic practice to obtain updated scientific and surgical information which is pertinent to their clinical practice. The educational format will consist of lectures with question and answer sessions as well as a panel discussion. Requirements for attendance at this program include a DDS or DMD degree from an American Dental Association approved Dental School or its equivalent and either graduation from or current active enrollment in a dental resident specialty or dental school.

UPON COMPLETION OF THIS COURSE, PARTICIPANTS WILL BE ABLE TO:

- 1) Understand the recent advances and diversity in dental surgery and oral and maxillofacial surgery.
- 2) Diagnose, prevent, and treat cases of jaw necrosis due to drug therapy and reconstructive techniques.
- 3) To discuss and coordinate dental and oral surgical concerns with prescribing physicians.
