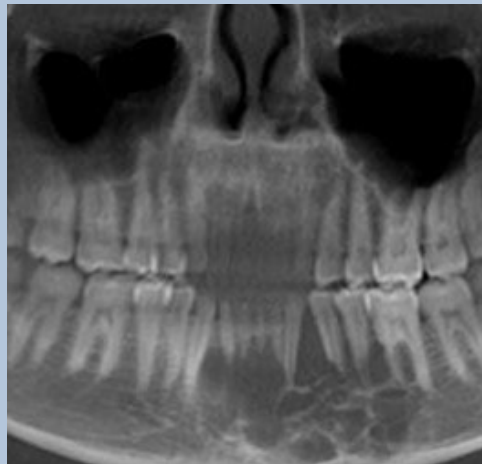

Course Description

Fifteen minutes per case with a following five minutes of questions and answers (Q & A) from typed in questions by registrants. The moderator will choose the best questions and propose them to the host and/or guest speakers. The moderator may also pose his own direct questions.
